**Appellation:** Saint-Véran (Burgundy) France  
**Varietals:** 100% Chardonnay

**Appellation:** The Saint-Véran (AOC), lies in the south of the Maconnais region, forming a belt around the appellation of Pouilly-Fuissé.

**Winery:** Located on a hillside overlooking the village of Pouilly, Domaine du Chalet Pouilly has been family owned and operated since 1850. The 8.5 hectare estate is shared between production of Pouilly Fuissé (5 hectares), Saint-Véran (3 hectares) and Mâcon-Solentré (0.5 hectares). The estate practices sustainable wine-growing methods and some plots are grown according to organic standards.

Seek out this 2017 Saint-Veran (AOC) from the Leger-Plumet's boutique family estate from 53-year-old vines. 100% Unoaked Chardonnay that delivers subtle stoney, citrus notes that gain intensity with aeration. Fresh and vibrant with a fine line of acidity. Delicate, but precise, with a tang of salinity that draws you back.
