



The Winery: Domaine de Cause is beautifully situated on top of a hill overlooking the Lot valley and the small valley of Thèze. It is 45 kms to the west of the town of Cahors. <https://domainedecause.fr/>

Husband and wife, **Serge and Martine COSTES** (fourth generation) resumed this beautiful family estate in 1994, wishing to offer continuity to Martine's parents' estate. They brought it new energy and ambition to develop high quality wines.

Serge practices agroecology sustainable farming favouring maximum use of approved specialty organic manual operations and an ecological approach. The grassy vineyards are certified HVE and they completed the conversion to organic with the 2022 harvest. The 15 hectares of vineyards of Domaine spread around a lovely stone hamlet "Cavagnac" marrying the slopes of the surrounding hillsides. The chalky, clay and limestone soils nourish the estate's biodynamic vines providing ripe fruit with blended, rounded tannins.

Cahors Malbecs tend to have more structure and firmer tannins than their Argentinian counterparts. They have an identifiable inky dark colour and strong aromatics, peppery and dry, whereas South American versions are on the whole lighter, vibrant and fruit-forward.
