The vineyards of this AOP are set around the most picturesque, visited and iconic Chateaux in the Loire Valley, of the same name, Chenonceau. One of the seven European vineyards, listed as World Heritage by UNESCO, the vineyards unfold as far as the eye can see. Fifty winegrowers passionately produce top of the range wines, the development of which requires precise and binding technical specifications, and marketing authorization subject to rigorous qualitative validation.

Most consumers know Loire Sauvignon Blanc because of Sancerre, but in Touraine the wines are a bit softer with more fruit and a mineral rather than grassy finish. The vines grow in on siliceous slopes on the left bank of the Cher. They rarely suffer from excess water stress and benefit from dry, free-draining rich soils.

This 100% Sauvignon Blanc –the signature grape varietal of the Touraine region–has been aged on its lees, in stainless steel tanks to bring richness to the wine. A refreshing, crisp white wine. Very fragrant with pineapple, passion and grapefruit aromas. The palate is round and well-balanced with a nice, delicate minerality.

SPEC +191580 Touraine Gamay 2024 - wholesale \$16.42

While Gamay is now made all over the world, France remains both its homeland and the place where it's being embraced anew. And not just in Beaujolais, but the many places throughout eastern and central France particularly in the Loire Valley, Gamay's stronghold is in Touraine.

A gorgeous shade of deep red reveals ripe red fruits on the nose, with a finely blended palate of black cherry and spice. Perfectly balanced with beautiful structure.



Appellation: Burgundy (Chablis) France



The Domaine practices "raisonnée" agriculture (minimizing the use of pesticides), and their wines express in pure form the typicality of Chablis. The Petit Chablis vineyards sit on the higher altitude slopes and plateaus in the region on Portlandian soil resulting in early ripening, with a more fruit-forward style. In this, it is distinct from its neighbouring terrior, which are dominated by Kimmeridgean soils. HVE 3 (High Environmental Value) and EVE vegan certified.

Winemaker, Thomas Labille's, Notes: "The yield and quality of the 22 vintage was really good. From 29 year old vines in Beines, Prehy and the plateau behind the Grand Crus on Portlandian clay. Vinified 8 months in stainless steel and a little enamel for elevage. We have a big 10-hectare parcel, so we are looking for something easy to drink. Always a lovely PC and this vintage is no exception; attractive citrus and a touch of minerality, nicely mouth-watering, but not too much, structured and very delicious."

The 2023 Pouilly Fuissé comes from 50-year-old vines and spends up to 20 months in French oak barrels. This dry 100% Chardonnay has aromas of ripe apple, peach and has mineral floral/white blossom notes with a citrus edge. The palate has wonderful rich fruit with rounded hazelnut and a light toasted character.



SPEC +148979: Saint-Veran 2023 wholesale \$26.83 – Certified Organic

Seek out this Saint-Veran (AOC) from the Leger-Plumet's boutique family estate from 53-year-old vines aged for six to eight months in stainless steel. 100% Unoaked Chardonnay that delivers subtle stony, citrus notes that gains intensity with aeration. Fresh and vibrant with a fine line of acidity. Delicate, but precise, with a tang of salinity that draws you back.

85% Merlot, 15% Malbec from clay limestone terroir. Cold maceration for a few days to extract fruit and spices from the skins. Fermentation at 26°C with regular pump overs. No oak aging to preserve fruit and freshness.

Quinta do Quetzal is located in the heart of the Alentejo region on the slopes of Vidigueira. The region's high daily temperature ranges, giving the plants the heat they need to ripen the grapes and the coolness to recover. The focus is on premium, quality wines expressing the character of the region, which that are produced in limited quantities. All Quinta do Quetzal wines are estate grown, produced exclusively with grapes from the property, which has 49 hectares of vineyards, of which around 1.5 hectares are old vines. These are complex and elegant wines, the result of a careful selection of grape varieties and aging in barrels.

Estate Grown Loureiro & Alvarinho, a step up from the entry frizzante Vinho Verde wines, this is a still white wine. It has a golden yellow colour, crisp and clean with great freshness and acidity. It has a vibrant rich mouth feel and is relatively dry (not a sweet wine) It expresses subtle flora notes and fruit aromas of apple, pear, pineapple & lemon. wholesale \$13.29

SPEC +179422 Quinta da Calçada Alvarinho Terroir 2024

This wine perfectly expresses both the terroir of the estate and the well structured, perfumed and age-worthy indigenous Alvarinho grape. A rich, dense texture, fine acidity and minerality is displayed in this lovely white wine. It has a warm, creamy edge that contrasts with its acidity. This premium, complex, food friendly wine represents the "noble grape" of the Vinho Verde region that delivers outstanding value for this high quality wine.

Owned and operated by the Meireles family from the town of Vila da Lixa since the mid-1980s, called "that Lixa wine". Carlos Teixeira, left town to make his name as one of Portugal's most respected oenologists, returned and is at the helm of this beloved winery today, producing textbook Vinhos Verdes at an unimpeachable level of quality.

SUPER SPEC +491759 Flores QL Vinho Verde DOC wholesale \$10.98

Flores Vinho Verde is a blend of three indigenous grapes from the lush, green region. Trajadura and Arinto provide body and length, as well as aromas and notes of crisp apple and tart lemon, lime and grapefruit. The Louriero provides the floral and aromatic herbal expression combining to create a lively, medium-dry white wine with a touch of spritz.



Appellation: Douro, Portugal

There are many legends that try to explain the name of this beautiful UNESCO World Heritage site. One of them says that, along the steep slopes, some shiny stones rolled down to the river, which they discovered to be of gold (Douro: of + gold). Another points out that the name may come from the Celtic word 'dur', which means water, but there is still another that tries to explain the name of the river with the Latin word 'duris', which means 'hard' and which could be an association with harshness of the landscapes that surround the Douro River.

Duris Selection has an intense ruby colour with violet tones. Aromas of red black fruits, slight floral with balsamic. In the mouth, it is a wine with a good volume, lively acidity and round tannins, with a persistent finish. During fermentation, gentle macerations are carried out. After fermentation, 30% of the blend aged in French and American oak for 6 months the remaining 70% aged in stainless steel

Appellation: Priorat (DOC) Spain

Priorat is a place of incredible natural beauty, with vines perched on impossibly steep hillside terraces (costers) covered by llicorella, decomposed slate topsoil, which contributes an incredible minerality. All wines are terroir-forward and made with low intervention and minimal sulfur at bottling. Winemaker, Jose Mas, achieves elegance, freshness, and precision by allowing the vineyards to guide their evolution without ever forcing their trajectory, practicing organic farming.

SPEC +669077: Costers Del Priorat, Pissarres 2019 **6 packs** wholesale \$29.13
Flagship wine. Pissarres is derived from "pizarra," which is "slate" in Spanish. The wine is a blend of organically-farmed grapes. A blend of 60% Samsó (Carignan) & 40% Garnacha from vineyards planted in 1934 on red llicorella using the traditional bush vine pruning technique and hand-harvesting. Spontaneously fermentation with indigenous yeasts in 3,000 and 5,000L stainless steel tanks with a small part in cement vats. Vinified separately. Aged 12 months in French oak barrels of 225 & 500L. Malolactic fermentation occurs spontaneously.



SPEC +689448: Costers Del Priorat, Clos Cypres Grand Cru 2018

Remarkable Reduction \$36.14 from \$73.66 Encased in wooden crate

Organically-farmed, west-facing vineyard at 300m, planted in 1934 at the historic Finca Sant Martí, named for the ancient cypress trees which stand on guard.

This carignan wines of Bellmunt transmit the luminosity and warmth of the Mediterranean; they are soft and generous with developed tannins and a cool minerality from the trademark red slate llicorella soils. Clos Cypres is a limited 100% samsó (carignan) Vi de Paratge (the Pinnacle of DOQ Priorat wines), built to improve with additional time in bottle. Wines are made with low intervention, manual harvest and minimal sulfur at bottling. 12 months French barrels

only 4 x 6 packs remaining .
