Barb Philip, Category Manager, MW: "Provence rosé is considered to be the finest pink wine in the world and the producers that make it are specialists. The vineyards are in the south of France and most of them are dedicated to making only rosé. Expect a very pale colour that ranges from salmon to dusty pink. The wine is always dry with delicate citrus, red fruits and wet stone flavours."

Appellation: (AOC) Coteaux Varois en Provence, France

The Domaine Saint-Ferréol estate, family owned since 1720, is situated deep in the countryside of Var, overlooking the vast plains of Pontevès, at the foot of the Bessillons peaks in Provence. Coteaux Varois en Provence is the smallest appellation in Provence, the most mountainous and furthest from the sea.

Terroir & Grape varieties:

The soil is clay-limestone which produces fresh, fruity wine. The varietals are a blend of Grenache (40%), Syrah (25%) Cinsault (15%) Carignan (15%) and Ugni-Blanc (5%)

Tasting Notes: "Lots of strawberry & raspberry fruit and a kiss of orange zest citrus mark this friendly, approachable rosé. Pours a fetching bright pastel pink and has good depth with a fresh snap. Presented in a lovely, elegant satin finish bottle."
